

# FRANK'S ZOO: CHAMPIONSHIP RUMBLE

In this beloved tournament variant of *Frank's Zoo* you tally your scores over multiple rounds until 2 or more players reach at least a total of 19 points. The player with the highest total wins.

Apply the following rules to play this variant:

- Play the first round as Wild Rumble.
- Starting with the second round and on, play the Team Rumble.
- Determine teams for each round by comparing all players' summed scores of all previous rounds (instead of just the last round). Then check the Overview card as usual to find your team.
- In case of a tie, the tied player who previously had the lower rank receives the higher rank.
- The player with the lowest rank becomes the new Dealer.



## SCORING EXAMPLE

The first Wild Rumble determines the rank for the second round: Doris 1st, Frank 2nd, Roland 3rd and Sabine 4th (Dealer).

After the second round both Doris and Sabine have 7 points. Since Sabine started the round with a lower rank, she now gets the higher rank.

The ranks for the third round are: Frank 1st, Sabine 2nd, Doris 3rd and Roland 4th (Dealer).

## HOW TO READ THE SCORING SHEET



Value of the Point card with little stars (received for going out, tiebreaker)



Value of the Point card without little stars (received from your team partner when they go out)



Total sum of points above (all numbers in the above block of the same color). Then compare totals to determine your rank and write it in the wreath shape.



Summed points for Lion and Hedgehogs. (Add up all bonuses and penalties, then write the total here.)

**Note:** Of course, you can also use this score sheet to keep track of your points with the normal Team Rumble rules. But if you ever come to one of Frank's championship tournaments (the designer Frank Nestel even attends them in person from time to time!) the above rules apply.
